

BY-LAW NUMBER 16-64

OF

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLEARVIEW

A By-law to provide for the erection of Stop Signs at certain intersections in the Township of Clearview

WHEREAS Section 137 of *The Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8 provides that the Council of a municipality may by by-law provide for the erection of stop signs at intersection on highways under its jurisdiction;


AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Township of Clearview deems it necessary and expedient to erect stop signs at certain designated locations provided every sign so erected complies with the regulations of the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Township of Clearview at their meeting held on June 27th, 2016 deems it necessary to erect 2 additional stops signs at the intersection of Townley Street and Queen Street East in the Village of Nottawa;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Clearview HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The intersection of highway set out in Column 1 is designated as the intersection where stop signs shall be erected at the location in Column 2 according to Schedule "A" attached.
2. That the penalties provided in Section 214 of *The Highway Traffic Act* shall apply to offenses against this by-law.
3. Each designation made by Section 1 shall not become effective until stop signs have been erected in accordance with the regulations of *The Highway Traffic Act*.
4. That stops signs may be removed in accordance with Section A2.2.1.3 Subsection (e) of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Canada.
5. That this By-Law shall come into force and effect on the date of final passing.

By-law Number 16-64 read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 18th day of July, 2016.
