

**BY-LAW NUMBER 17-75**

**OF**

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLEARVIEW**

**Being a by-law to provide for the erection of stop signs at certain intersections in the Township of Clearview**

**WHEREAS** Section 137 (a) of *The Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8 as amended provides that the Council of a Municipality may by by-law provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections in highways under its jurisdiction

**AND WHEREAS** Council deems it expedient to install a number of stop signs at certain intersections in the Township of Clearview

**NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLEARVIEW HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The intersection of highway set out in Column 1 is designated as the intersection where stop signs shall be erected at the location in Column 2 according to Schedule "A" attached.
2. That the penalties provided in Section 214 of The Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offenses against this by-law.
3. Each designation made by Section 1 shall not become effective until stop signs have been erected in accordance with the regulations of *The Highway Traffic Act*.
4. That stop signs may be removed in accordance with Section A2.2.1.3 Subsection (e) of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Canada.
5. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of final passing thereof.

By-law Number 17-75 read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 25<sup>th</sup> day September, 2017.
