

**BY-LAW NUMBER 17-112**

**OF**

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLEARVIEW**

**A By-law to Appoint an Alternate Member to the Council of the County of Simcoe during an absence of the Mayor or Deputy Mayor**

**WHEREAS** Bill 68, Modernizing Ontario's Municipal Legislation Act, 2017 received Royal Assent on May 30, 2017, and amends the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, herein referred to as the "Act";

**AND WHEREAS** section 268(1) of the Act provides that the council of a local municipality may appoint one of its members as an Alternate Member to the upper-tier council, to act in place of a person who is a member of the councils of the local municipality and its upper-tier municipality, when the person is unable to attend a meeting of the upper-tier council for any reason;

**AND WHEREAS** the Lieutenant Governor proclaimed that January 1, 2018 is the date that Section 268(1) of the Act regarding Alternate Members will take force;

**NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLEARVIEW HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Councillor Shawn Davidson is hereby appointed as the Alternate Member to Simcoe County Council for the term of the council that appointed them, or until their appointment by-law is rescinded, or November 30 in the year of a Regular Election, or until such time as the Alternate Member's seat is declared vacant in accordance with section 259 of the Act.
2. The Alternate Member appointed herein shall not sit on behalf of the Mayor or Deputy Mayor at an Inaugural Meeting of County Council.
3. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day the Lieutenant Governor proclaims Section 268 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended in force.

By-law 17-112 read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 11<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2017.
